The History of the Rock of the Clyde

Dumbarton Rock...has been the site of an important settlement from as far back as the Iron Age. It is first recorded in Saint Patrick's letter to King Ceretic of Alt Clut, (or Rock of the Clyde) in the 5th century.

From the 5th century AD until 1018, Dumbarton Rock was the capital of the British kingdom of Strathclyde. Legend tells of Merlin the magician staying at King Riderch's court. The Rock was besieged several times, but the Viking assault in 870 was by far the worst. After a four-month siege, Kings Olaf and Ivar of Dublin carried off the slaves and looted treasure in 200 longships.

Dumbarton Castle...(Dùn Breatainn -the fortress of the Britons') was an important royal castle in medieval Scotland. It sheltered David II (Robert the Bruce's son) and his young wife, Queen Joan, after

the Scottish defeat at Halidon Hill near Berwick-upon-Tweed in 1333. In 1548, after the disastrous Battle of Pinkie, east of Edinburgh, the castle protected the infant Mary, Queen of Scots for several months before her safe removal to France.

Mary visited Dumbarton Castle after her return to Scotland, 13 years later. In 1568, she was moving towards Dumbarton Castle after her escape from Lochleven Castle when her forces were intercepted and defeated at the Battle of Langside. Mary fled to England and captivity, never to return.

Dumbarton castles' importance declined after Oliver Cromwell's death in 1658. But threats posed by Jacobites and the French in the eighteenth century caused new structures and defences to be built and the castle continued to be garrisoned until WWII.
